  - You may search the web
- Cite for written or short answer
  - Class notes: include citation for direct quotes;
  - Online: include citation for both paraphrased content or direct quotes
  - However, in general, you should be using content learned during the course to answer questions instead of using content online

# Quiz: Things you CANNOT do

- Quiz is “Closed-Friends”:
  - You may **not** accept any help from another person (room mate, family, friend in class, friend not-in-class, paid person on Chegg, random person in hall)
- You may **not** plagiarize
  - For written answers, you should not copy-and-paste content from online or notes: you may use those sources to write your own answer
  - If you either quote or paraphrase you must cite

# Enforcing Academic Honesty

- **CourSys**
  - must accept academic honesty policy
  - must submit webcam selfie when submitting
  - If image submission fails, or no web-cam: submit without photo and email me a selfie; exam will be scrutinized
- **Questions**
  - Some randomization; semester long analysis
- **Interviews**
  - After each quiz a TA will interview ~10% of class to verify their performance is similar to score on quiz
- Anyone caught cheating will likely get 0 AND lose 100%
